A Guide For Male Escorts

You can make an excellent part time living as a non sexual male escort with the Cavendish Knights Agency and you will find it to be interesting, fun, and VERY REWARDING!

We are Strictly a Non-Sexual male escort agency and our clients are not looking for anything other than good company! Women who require more can easily find that kind of service elsewhere on the internet!



You will earn £90 hour whatever the time of day and our commission is paid to us by the client and not you. We have over 17,000 fully signed up female members who use our service and most are career women who need a male escort to accompany them to the theatre, dinner, a party, or a business function of some kind. In the members area of the site they choose an escort by different criteria and then make a booking directly with us.

You will not incur any cost on the date as the client will pay for everything. Our minimum booking time is 2 hours and the average date is 4 hours long. Occasionally a client may need someone to accompany them to a business conference or something similar and for these longer dates, we negotiate an all-in price and agree a fixed fee with you. The client will pay you at the end of the date.

Ninety percent of dates take place in major towns and cities across the UK and we try our best to ensure that you never have to travel to far for any date. Most dates require less than 30 minutes travelling time and you will be paid from the time you meet the client until the time that you leave them. If you live in a rural area you may have to travel a little farther if you want to be kept busy with dates.

You don't have to have the looks of a film star to be an escort; however you should be of smart appearance, well groomed, sociable and reliable. Your client for the evening wants a man who is polite, charming and a good listener, and they're not paying to hear all about you and your problems! You probably already know whether you would make an ideal escort and if you think you would then you should certainly give it serious consideration.

If you wish to become a male escort, you should start by completing our application form and return it to the agency as soon as possible. We will start to process your application as soon as it arrives and you will hear back from us within 7 days.

Due to the nature of the work, we need to make a discrete background check to ensure you are who you claim to be. No-one but you will be aware that we are making these checks!

Questions & Answers

Q. Who are Cavendish Knights?

A. Cavendish Knights is a privately owned company based in Alresford, Hampshire, United Kingdom.

Q. How long have you been in business?

A. Cavendish Knights was founded in April 2000 under the name SIGUK. The company changed its name to Cavendish Knights as part of our re-branding program in January 2004.

Q. Is there an age limit to be a Cavendish Knight?

A. You need to be 19 - 77 years old.

Q. Do I have to pay you any fees?

A. No. The Client pays us a booking fee of £50 per booking.

Q. Do you need a picture of me with the application form?

A. Yes, initially we just need a snap to see what you look like. If accepted we will need a better quality picture for the members section of the site.

Q. Can I use a false name, or false address?

A. No and there really is no need to do so.

Q. I'm married and don't want my wife to know that I'm working as an escort.

A. That's between you and her. We will not inform anyone you work for us.

Q. How long does it take to process an application?

A. Normally just 7 days after receipt but please allow 10 days before following up. Once approved we will email you details to upload your profile and carry out updates.

An Escort's First Date

Shortly after my application and security checks being accepted by Cavendish Knights, my profile was uploaded onto the agency's web site. Before long I had a telephone call from Tony Perry, a senior partner in the company, to inform me that a client had expressed an interest in hiring me for accompaniment to a function.



Being my first experience of working for a male escort agency, I was naturally nervous about my first appointment, and about how I would come across and whether I would fulfil the expectations of the client. I decided that the best approach was to be confident, but also reserved, as I was sure the

client would be just as, if not more, nervous than myself.

The details of the appointment were outlined by Mr Perry, and on my acceptance, my contact details were given to the client so that we could liaise and sort out where to meet, what I should wear etc.

The meeting place and timings were arranged, and on the evening I arrived in good time to meet the client. On her arrival, I introduced myself, and we discussed the details of the evening, such as who would be there, and how I was to be perceived by the other guest (i.e. as her boyfriend, relative, work colleague etc). We then proceeded to the function, and enjoyed a friendly dinner, drinks and dance.

I found my balance of confidence and politeness was the correct mix, as it put the client at ease, as this was obviously a nervous experience for her too. At the end of the day, I was to provide the agency's service as an escort, so it was my responsibility to act professionally, and provide her with the service required. This meant the experience was to be enjoyable as possible, while being stress-free also.

At the end of the evening, the strict policy of Cavendish Knights as a "straight, non-sexual" agency meant that there was no awkwardness, of the type that may spring to mind with many peoples' conception of an escort agency, and this made the end of the evening both comfortable and respectful for both parties.

Questions & Answers

Q. How many hours a week will I work?

A. This varies according to the time of year and how popular you are! Your picture and self-description appear in the member's area of our web site and clients pick the escort they want in your area. Some escorts are always going to be more popular than others. We recommend you think of this as a part-time opportunity that just happens to pay rather well! You will not get rich working as an escort I'm afraid.

Q. Will you check me out to ensure I am who I claim to be?

A. Yes, we use a company to verify your details against those held on the electoral roll.

Q. I'm not on the electoral roll.

A. We use a professional company to do our checks and if you exist they will be able to confirm it

Q. I'm a foreign national.

A. We need your previous address back home so we can check you out.

Q. Can I just provide a utility bill as evidence instead?

A. No, to protect our clients we insist on doing things our way, as it's very easy to get a utility bill showing your name at someone else's address!

Q. How do I get paid?

A. The client will pay you at the end of the date

Q. Do you employ women?

A. No. We're not in that type of business!

Q. Will I need to use my own car?

A. No, not at all. The only reason we ask about your car is to ensure you can get to dates reliably.

There's no shortage of conversation, especially when Mark volunteers that he has just been mugged (welcome to Britain) and had a tooth knocked out at a bus stop in south London. Half an hour later, we arrive at the party, where we immediately bump into two of my former colleagues from a Sunday newspaper: Jane, a showbiz columnist, and Andrea, a crime reporter. It's time to test the story.

Q. Who pays for everything on a date?

A. The client pays for everything.

Q. How much notice do you give for a date and what if I can't make it?

A. You will normally get a minimum notice of half a day, usually more. If you can't make a date then we'll arrange it for someone else.

Q. What happens if I agree to a date and fail to keep it?

A. You will need the best excuse in the world, which we will check! Failing that, you will never work for us again.

Q. Is this a serious opportunity and how do I know I can trust you?

A. Yes, we have over 17,000 fully signed up female members. We have been positively reviewed by the BBC1, ITV, C4 and C5 TV stations. Most national and local radio stations. We have also had very good press in almost every national newspaper and most top magazines. We have also appeared as invited guest on C5 and BBC1 TV.

Q. Will I be employed by you?

A. No, your earnings from us are classed as self-employed and you will be responsible for your own tax and national insurance.

Q. How much will I earn per hour?
